#### Discussion with Practitioners from Japanese, U.S. Universities and Participants

Practitioners from U.S. universities will introduce their systems for ensuring *research security* and *research integrity*, operational challenges, and practical on-site solutions from their perspective. In addition, after sharing insights on the interplay between legal functions and risk management (such as export control) at Japanese universities, a plenary discussion will examine the systems, functions, challenges, and strategies necessary for university personnel to ensure *research security* and *research integrity*.
